IV. PUBLIC COMMENTS

1. Executive Session: Pursuant to the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, Sections 551.071, 551.072, 551.073, 551.074, 551.076, 551.087 and the Texas Disaster Act, Sections 418.0183(f) and 418.106(d) & (e), the City Council reserves the right to convene in Executive Session as deemed necessary during this meeting to receive advice from its attorney as permitted by law, or to discuss the following as permitted by the Texas Government Code :

Discuss and take possible action on Ordinance 2022-0707, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW, TEXAS, AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 2, "ADMINISTRATION" OF THE GRANDVIEW CODE OF ORDINANCES, AMENDING THE APPOINTMENT, REMOVAL, DUTIES, RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE POLICE CHIEF; LIMITING THE CITY MANAGER'S AUTHORITY OVER THE POLICE CHIEF, POLICE DEPARTMENT, POLICE OFFICERS, AND POLICE DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE OF ALL ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
