**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-0901D**

**CITY MANAGER APPOINTMENT**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW, TEXAS, AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW. APPOINTING A CITY MANAGER; SETTING THE SALARY OF THE CITY MANAGER; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE OF ALL ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS,** the city of Grandview, Texas, is a Type A general-law municipality located in Johnson County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code, and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

**WHEREAS,** the City Council desires to appoint, Don Moore, to the position of City Manager; and

**WHEREAS,** the City Council desires to define the duties and obligations of the City Manager and give the City Manager full authority over employment of city staff without council interference;

**WHEREAS,** the City Council desires to set the City Manager's salary, as required by state law.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW:**

**SECTION 1.**

On a basis of his administrative ability, Don Moore is hereby appointed as City Manager of the City of Grandview, Texas.

**SECTION 2.**

The city manager's salary shall be \$135,000.00 annually. All remaining terms of employment shall be established pursuant to a mutually acceptable employment agreement.

SECTION 3.

The ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances of the City of Grandview, Texas, as amended, except where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances and such Code are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgement or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in the ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

SECTION 5.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and it is so ordained.
