

**CITY OF GRANDVIEW
ORDINANCE NO. 2022-0915A**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW, TEXAS, ADOPTING
A BUDGET AMENDMENT TO THE ORIGINAL OPERATING BUDGET
FOR THE 2021-2022 FISCAL YEAR; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY;
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Grandview, Texas, is a Type A general-law municipality located in Johnson County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 2021-0916, the City Council of the City of Grandview, Texas, adopted its budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that adjustment to more accurate forecasts of revenue and expenses is appropriate and in the best interest of prudent budgeting; and

WHEREAS, Section 102.010 of the Texas Local Government Code allows the City Council to make changes to the budget for municipal purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW:

SECTION 1.

That the fiscal year budget for 2021-2022 for the City of Grandview, Texas is hereby amended as reflected in the attached Exhibit "A", Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Proposed Budget with adoption adjustments.

SECTION 2.

In the event any clause, phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstance shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this ordinance as a whole or any part of provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Grandview, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.

SECTION 3.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and it is so ordained.
